



Nursing Care Course Bekka

Admission Guide

1. Purpose

This course is designed primarily for international students who wish to become care workers. We provide students with specialized education related to nursing care and contribute to society by developing care workers with the communication skills, self-discipline, and global perspective necessary to play active societal roles. Furthermore, we offer a wide range of support so that students can obtain a national qualification as a "care worker" and find employment at nursing care facilities in Japan after graduation.

2. Period of Study and Enrollment

3. Qualification

Those who satisfy any of the following conditions ① through ⑤.

- ① Those who graduate from high school (including prospective graduates) or those with equivalent or higher academic ability.
- ② Those who have completed a 12-year curriculum of schooling in their home country.
- ③ Those recognized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology as having the academic ability equivalent or higher to those who have completed a 12-year education curriculum outside Japan.
- ④ Those who have successfully passed the "Certificate for Students Achieving the Proficiency Level of Upper Secondary School Graduates."
- ⑤ Those who have completed at least three years of upper secondary courses at a specialized training college.

4. Application Procedure

② Application Period

April Entry: The last day of November (previous year)

③ Selection Method

Admission decisions will be made based on screening the application documents, a Japanese examination (essay writing), and an interview.

④ Screening Fee(in Japanese yen)

25,000yen

5. Application Documents

Documents to be submitted		Details
1	Osaka Christian College Application Form	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fill in the designated form with a black ballpoint pen and affix your seal.• Attach your ID photograph. (4cm x 3cm, taken within the last three months)
2	Pasteboard for the certificate of payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Paste the certificate of payment of your screening fee.
3	Statement of Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write your reasons for applying to the Nursing Care Course Bekka on the designated form.
4	Letter of Recommendation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only required if there is a recommendation from a Japanese language school in Japan.
5	Copy of your academic diploma and latest transcript	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Your diploma and transcript from the last school you attended (in your home country) and their translations.
6	Letter of Graduation (Prospective), academic transcript, and certificate of attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only international students expected to graduate by the application deadline must submit these forms. (Transcripts and attendance certificates must be in the form of each school)
7	Copy of Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certificate of Japanese Language Proficiency Test. (JLPT)
8	Copy of Passport (Identification page)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Page with information on status and permission to engage in activities other than those permitted by the quality of residence previously granted.
9	Copy of residence card (both sides)

*Education Enhancement Fee covers Extracurricular Activities Fee, Facility Fee, Health Checkup Fee, and Insurance Fee for international students.

*Financial aid is available for international students.

7. Return of Fees

- Your screening fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- If the Japanese Embassy or Consulate denies the visa issuance, all fees except the screening and admission fees are refunded.
- If you cancel your enrollment by the first day of the month of your registration (April). All payments except the screening and admission fees will be refunded for personal reasons.
- If you withdraw within six months of enrollment, your tuition fee for the relevant semester (6 months) will not be refunded.
- If you violate any laws, regulations, or school rules and are expelled, you will not be entitled to any refund.

8. Scholarship for International Students

※If you wish to apply for the following scholarships, consult us in advance.

①International Student Special Scholarship

- This scholarship is given to academically outstanding students studying to become care workers who can serve as role models for other students.

②A Student Loan to Become a Certified Care Worker

- This student loan is provided for those enrolled in schools to obtain the license to work as certified care workers. They are exempted from the payment if certain conditions are met, such as working as a certified care worker in designated facilities for several years.

③ Scholarship Programs Offered by Welfare and Nursing Care Facilities.

- A loan program by corporate welfare and nursing care facilities.

9. Student Life

(1) Student Dormitories

- All international students at Osaka Christian College must live in a designated dormitory.
- A 5,000 yen/month housing aid is available for all international students. Rooms are equipped with mini-kitchen, bath/lavatory/toilet, desk, chair, refrigerator, futon set, air conditioner, closet, and fully automatic washing machine. Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi) Internet access is also available so you can start your study abroad immediately after arrival.
- 25,000 yen/month + 5,000 yen/month housing aid→30,000 yen (You will be provided a room worth 60,000 yen/month and share with one other student.

① Fees (All amounts in Japanese yen)

International students entering Osaka Christian College from Bekka are not required to pay the admission fee and the security deposit.

② Payment Method

From the 4th month, students must pay 25,000 yen per month at the designated payment office.

International students entering Osaka Christian College from Bekka must also pay 25,000 yen monthly.

(2) Part-time Job Placement Service

Students can work part-time up to 28 hours per week (40 hours per week during long vacations). We will arrange a safe place for you to work.
