DX Global Class

Admission Guide

1. Purpose

This course is intended primarily for international students to develop their knowledge of ICT technology and DX and pass the "Fundamental Information Technology Engineer Examination" (FE). Students will be awarded an associate degree upon successful completion of the course. In addition, Osaka Christian College will help students to find employment in Japanese ICT companies after graduation.

2. Period of Study and Enrollment

3. Qualification

Those who satisfy all the following conditions (1) through (4).

- (1) Those who with foreign nationality.
- (2) Those who fall under the following ① through ③.
 - ① Those who have completed a 12-year curriculum of schooling in their home country.
 - ② Those recognized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology as having the same or higher qualifications.
 - ③ Those who have acquired any of the international qualifications for admission to a university (International Baccalaureate, Baccalaureate, and Abitur) in a foreign country.

*In either case, applicants must be 18 by the enrollment date.



(3) Those who have studied Japanese for more than 600 hours at a Japanese language institute or have Japanese language proficiency equivalent to the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2 level or higher.

(4) Those who can obtain the " Student " residence status in Japan.

4. Application Procedure

We will support prospective students during the initial stage of application. Please contact us at the address in this guide's last section. We will explain the documents required for the application.

(1) Application Period

Application Period: Oct 10(Tue), 2023 – Nov 1(Wed), 2023

Selection Date: Nov 11(Sat), 2023

Announcement of Result: Nov 22(Wed), 2023

(2) Selection Method

Admission decisions will be made based on screening the application documents, a Japanese examination (essay writing), and an interview.

(3) Screening Fee (in Japanese yen)

30,000 yen

For overseas remittances, prior consultation by e-mail is required.

(For those residing in Japan, the payment can be made at convenience stores.)

Details of Application Documents

(1) Statement of Purpose * Please use the designated form

(2) Certificate related to academic background

①Certificate of Japanese Language proficiency

(If the applicant took the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), submit a copy of the results)

②Final Academic Diploma(Or Certificate of Enrollment if currently enrolled in a university)

③Official Latest Academic Transcript

(3)Copy of the Passport

Submit a copy of the following pages from your passport: The page includes your name and the photograph of your face, and all pages contain all previous records of entry and departure to and from Japan. If you do not possess a passport, submit a copy of an Identification Card or documents issued by your home country's government.

(4)Sponsor Documents

Documents proving the ability to pay tuition, living expenses, etc.

① Letter of Financial Support *Please use the designated form

② Certificates to prove financial ability

1. Financial Statement / Official Bank Statement

2. Certificate of Employment

3. A document that proves the relationship between the applicant and the sponsor

*We may also ask you to submit additional documents as necessary.



6. Fees (All amounts in Japanese yen)

*Education Enhancement Fee covers Extracurricular Activities Fee, Facility Fee, Health Checkup Fee, and Insurance Fee for international students.

*Financial aid (tuition reduction and exemption) is available for privately financed international students.

7. Return of Fees

- Your screening fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- If the Japanese Embassy or Consulate denies the visa issuance, all fees except the admission fee will be refunded.
- If you cancel your enrollment for personal reasons before entering Japan, all fees except the admission fee will be refunded.
- If you withdraw from enrollment between your arrival and the first day of the enrollment month (April), all fees except the admission fee will be refunded.
- If you withdraw within six months of enrollment, your tuition fee for the relevant semester (6 months) will not be refunded.
- If you violate any laws, regulations, or school rules and are expelled, you will not be entitled to any refund.



8. Tuition Exemption and Reduction Program for Privately Financed International Students

Qualification

Those who satisfy all the following conditions (1) through (3).

(1) Those admitted to our school as privately financed international students have or will have the residence status of "Student."

(2) Those who have financial difficulties.

(3) Those who have achieved outstanding results in Japanese language study.

Application Method

Applicants must submit the application form during the admission procedure period.

Screening Method and Determination

Tuition exemptions will be offered after a comprehensive evaluation based on interviews and other comprehensive screening. After approval, your admission fee and tuition will be reduced by 30% to 70%.

*The "JASSO Type 2 Scholarship Income Criteria" will be used as a reference for the household income.

Reduction/Exemption Process

The amount of the tuition reduction will be deducted from your tuition payment.

9. Tuition Reimbursement Program

Qualification

Those who satisfy all the following conditions (1) through (5).

(1) Those admitted to our school as privately financed international students have or will have the residence status of "Student."

(2) Those who passed JLPT N2 or higher.

(3) Those who passed the "Fundamental Information Technology Engineer Examination" (FE).

(4) Those employed by a company designated by Osaka Christian College.

(5) Those who have excellent academic achievement as well as excellent daily attitude.



Application Period

Around October of your second year

Amount of Reimbursement

If your tuition reimbursement is approved after the screening, the company you work for will refund the tuition. The reimbursement amount is calculated based on the length of service with the company.

Length of Employment	Amount of Reimbursement
Three years	50% Refund of Tuition
Five years	Full Refund of Tuition

10. Student Life

(1) Student Dormitories

All international students at Osaka Christian College must live in a designated dormitory.

A 5,000 yen/month housing aid is available for all international students. Rooms are equipped with mini-kitchen, bath/lavatory/toilet, desk, chair, refrigerator, futon set, air conditioner, closet, and fully automatic washing machine. Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi) Internet access is also available so you can start your study abroad immediately after arrival.

25,000 yen/month + 5,000 yen/month housing aid→30,000 yen (You will be provided a room worth 60,000 yen/month and share with one other student.

① Fees (All amounts in Japanese yen)

International students entering Osaka Christian College from Bekka are not required to pay the admission fee and the security deposit.

②Payment Method

From the 4th month, students must pay 25,000 yen per month at the designated payment office.

International students entering Osaka Christian College from Bekka must also pay 25,000 yen monthly.

(2) Part-time Job Placement Service

Students can work part-time up to 28 hours per week (40 hours per week during long vacations). We will arrange a safe place for you to work.
