



Preparatory Japanese Language Course (Nihongo Bekka) Admission Guide (Special Admission for Privately-Financed International Students)

1. Purpose

This course aims to provide preparatory education for international students who wish to enroll in Osaka Christian College by offering Japanese language education and other necessary classes such as Japanese culture and Japanese affairs. (2-year Course and 1 year and 6 months Course are available.) In addition, students will acquire advanced Japanese language skills, such as writing reports and discussions needed for studying at Osaka Christian College, and will become globally active human resources through international exchange.

2. Special Admission for Privately- Financed International Students

(1) Special Admission

Osaka Christian College offers a "Special admission" system for privately financed international students with financial difficulties. We welcome students who meet all of the following characteristics.

- ① Students with financial difficulties.
- ② Students who intend to enroll in Osaka Christian College (the DX Global Class of the EdTech Course or the Nursing Care Course) after completing the Preparatory Japanese Language Course, Nihongo Bekka in principle.
- ③ Students who have passed the entrance examination with excellent scores.

3. Qualification

Those who have strong intentions of entering Osaka Christian College after completing the Preparatory Japanese Language Course and meet all of the requirements listed below (1) through(4)

(1) Those who with foreign nationality.

(2) Those who fall under any of the following ① through ③.

① Those who have completed a 12-year curriculum of schooling in their home country.

② Those recognized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science, and Technology as having the academic ability equivalent or higher to those who have completed a 12-year education curriculum outside Japan.

③ Those who have acquired any of the international qualifications for admission to a university (International Baccalaureate, Baccalaureate, and Abitur) in a foreign country.

*In either case, applicants must be 18 by the enrollment date.

(3) Those who have studied Japanese for more than 150 hours or have Japanese language proficiency equivalent to the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N5 level or higher.

(4) Those who can obtain the “Student“ residence status in Japan.



4. Application Procedure

We will support prospective students during the initial stage of application. Please contact us at the address in this guide's last section. We will explain the documents required for the application.

(1) Application Period

(2) Selection Method

Admission decisions will be made based on a screening of the application documents, a Japanese written examination, and an interview.

① Certificate of Japanese Language proficiency

(If the applicant took the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), submit a copy of the results)

② Final Academic Diploma (Or Certificate of Enrollment if currently enrolled in a university)

④ Official Latest Academic Transcript



(4) Copy of the Passport

Submit a copy of the following pages from your passport: The page includes your name, your face photograph, and all pages containing all previous records of entry and departure to and from Japan. If you do not possess a passport, submit a copy of an Identification Card or documents issued by your home country's government.

(5) ID Photo (Passport style, taken within the last three months)

(6) Sponsor Documents

Documents proving the ability to pay tuition, living expenses, etc.

- ① Letter of financial support *Please use the designated form
- ② Certificates to prove financial ability
 1. Financial Statement / Official Bank Statement
 2. Certificate of Employment
 3. A document that proves the relationship between the applicant and the sponsor

*We may also ask you to submit additional documents as necessary.

*Education Enhancement Fee covers Extracurricular Activities Fee, Facility Fee, Health Checkup Fee, and Insurance Fee for international students.

*Tuition installment payment is 50,000 yen monthly and must be paid monthly at the designated office.



7. Return of Fees

- Your screening fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- If the Japanese Embassy or Consulate denies the visa issuance, all fees except the admission fee will be refunded.
- If you cancel your enrollment for personal reasons before entering Japan, all fees except the admission fee will be refunded.
- If you withdraw from enrollment between your arrival and the first day of the enrollment month (April/October), all fees except the admission fee will be refunded.
- If you withdraw within 6 months of enrollment, your tuition fee for the relevant semester (6 months) will not be refunded.
- If you violate any laws, regulations, or school rules and are expelled, you will not be entitled to any refund.

8. Student Life

(1) Student Dormitories

All international students at Osaka Christian College must live in a designated dormitory.

A 5,000 yen/month housing aid is available for all international students. Rooms are equipped with mini-kitchen, bath/lavatory/toilet, desk, chair, refrigerator, futon set, air conditioner, closet, and fully automatic washing machine. Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi) Internet access is also available so you can start your study abroad immediately after arrival.

25,000 yen/month + 5,000 yen/month housing aid → 30,000 yen (You will be provided a room worth 60,000 yen/month and share with one other student.

② Payment Method

From the 4th month, students must pay 25,000 yen per month at the designated payment office.

(2) Part-time Job Placement Service
